CHANGE TO THE OFFICIAL VMSC COMPETITION REGULATIONS:

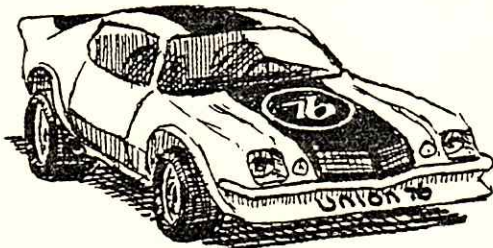
Competition Regulations, Section 13, Rally Evaluation Reports, Paragraph B:

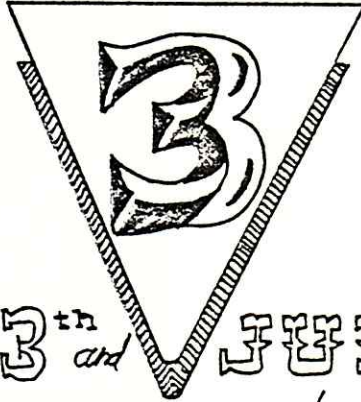
