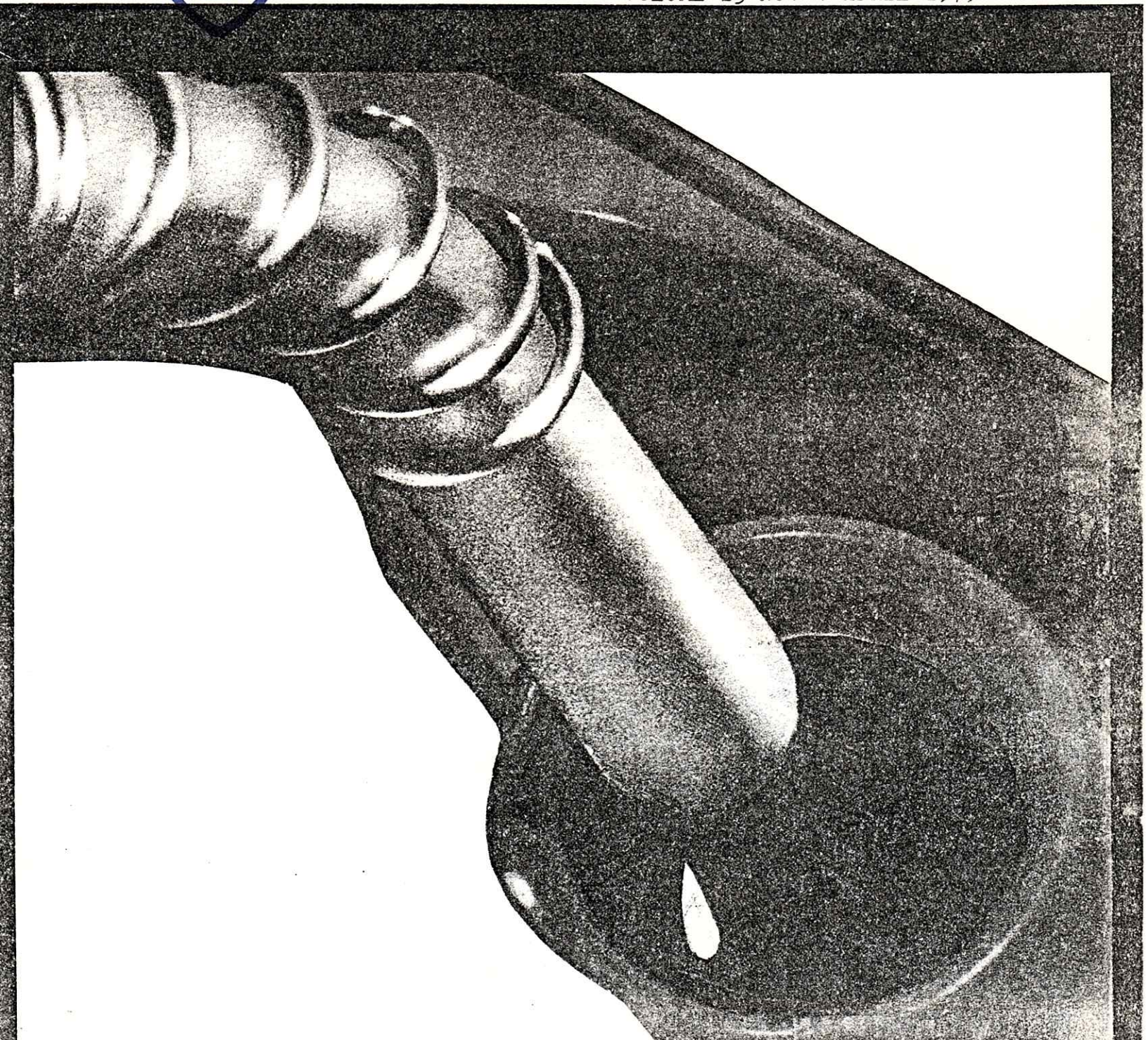

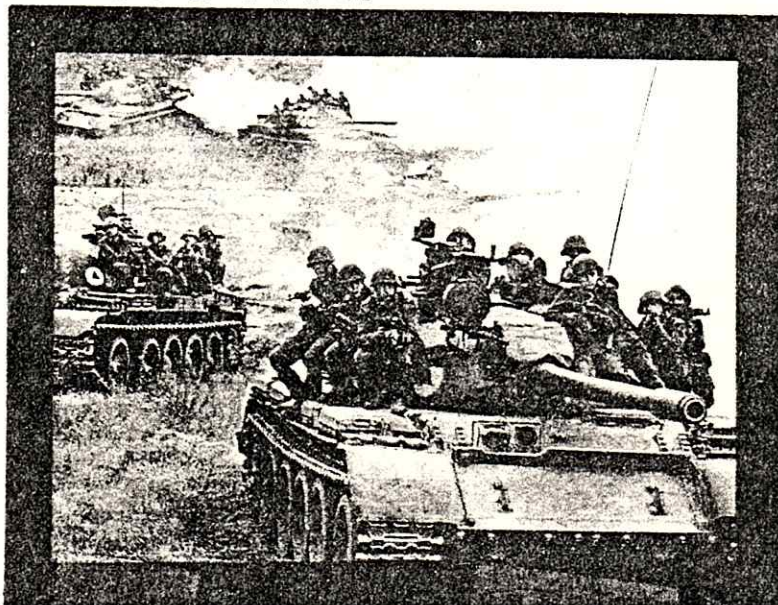

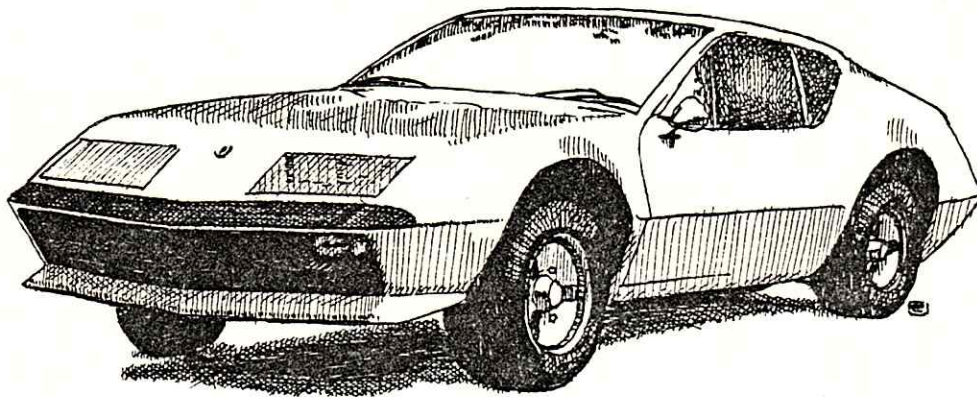

If you think VMSC has changed a lot in the last twenty-odd years, consider these selected excerpts from the minutes of past meetings:

Board meeting - April 25, 1957

Suggestions were made that the Club conduct Rallye Schools and run Novice Rallies for new members. No definite decision was made.

Ed Wright presented to the Club an "IT" hard luck trophy to be awarded each month. This member to be selected by the Committee of Ed Wright, M. McClintic, R. Walker.

Ed Wright suggested that an Annual Trophy be given to the Club member who contributes the most towards Sports Car Racing. The President suggested that he assume this responsibility and that the same be borne by all future Presidents.

Activities Chairman, Madison McClintic, reminded all concerned that average speeds of Rallies should be kept down to eliminate dangerous driving by participants who become lost.

Regular monthly meeting - May 16, 1957

Suggestions were made that VMSC purchase Jackets (Blazers) and Coveralls with Club insignia.

Ed Wright presented to John Kessler the "IT" trophy for having the most hard luck since the last meeting. That is: "Ramming a Mercury with his Triumph." Honorable mention goes to Ted Remick for having been stopped by the greatest number of law-enforcing Officers during period of Apr. 18 through May 16, 1957.

Regular monthly meeting - June 20, 1957

Motion was made and carried that the OLD DOMINION RALLYE be established as an Annual affair.

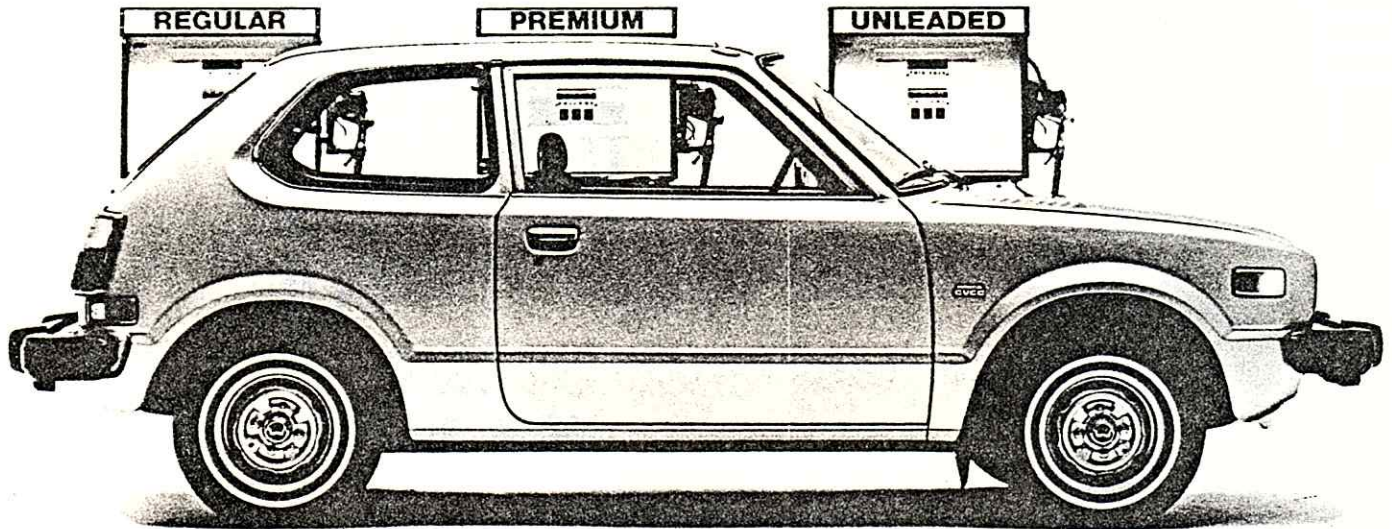
Board meeting - August 12, 1958

The first order of business was the subject of "Lack of enthusiasm on part of Club members not attending Rallies, etc." Discussion was held and the main complaints seem to be the following: too many; rally speeds too high; lack of CHECK POINTS; members tired of Rallies; too technical; members not winning. It was suggested that the old and new members be mixed up as Drivers and Navigators on certain Rallies; that an occasional "after meeting night" Rallye be held; that a gift be given everyone who runs a rallye.

Regular monthly meeting - May 21, 1959

The Club's car badges were ordered and upon receipt were found to be the wrong color and also had the wrong brackets. This will have to be adjusted.

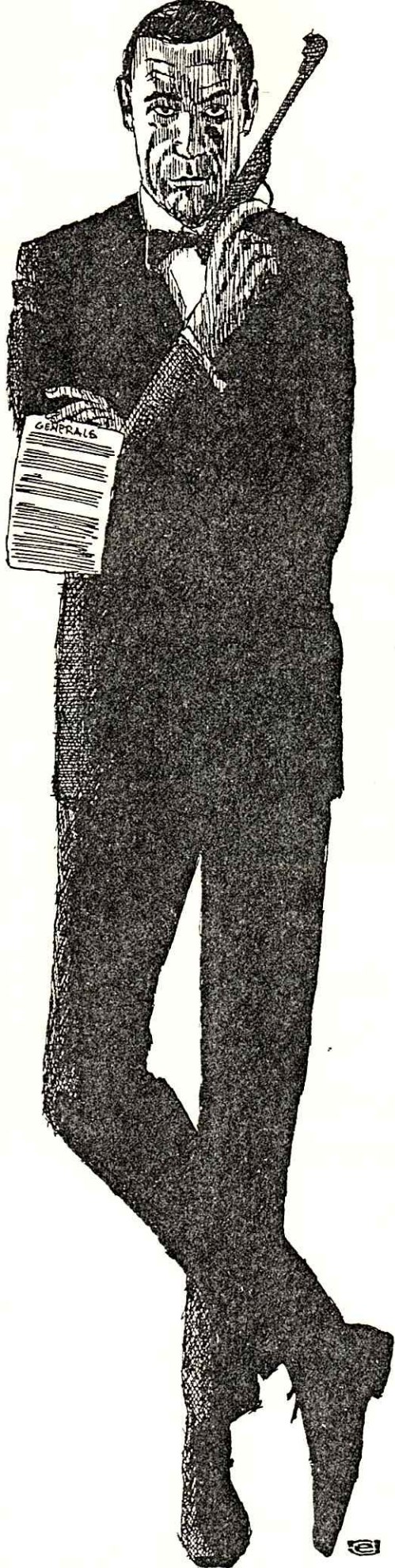

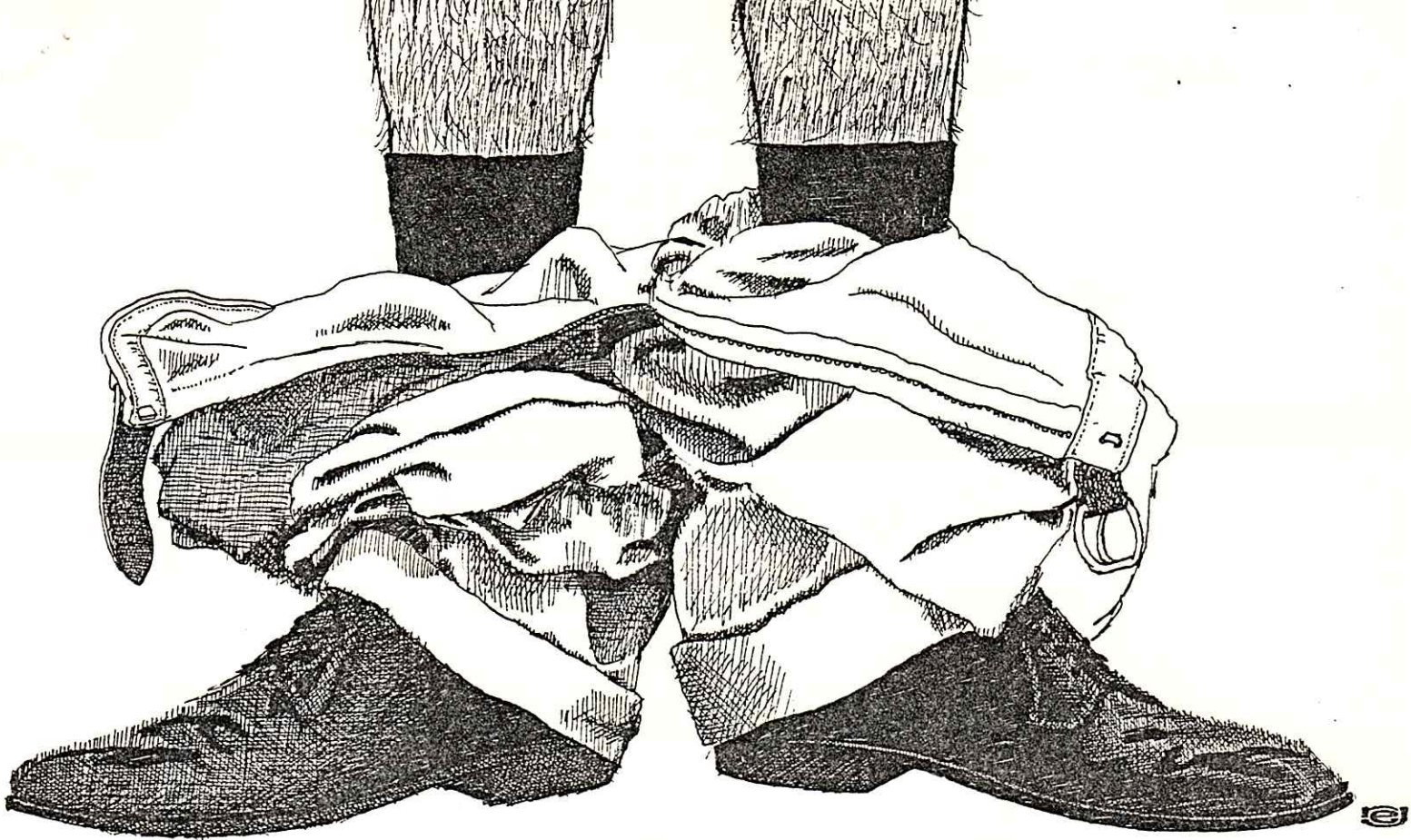

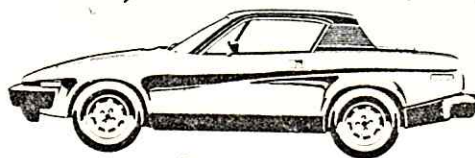
