NOISE FROM THE ATTIC

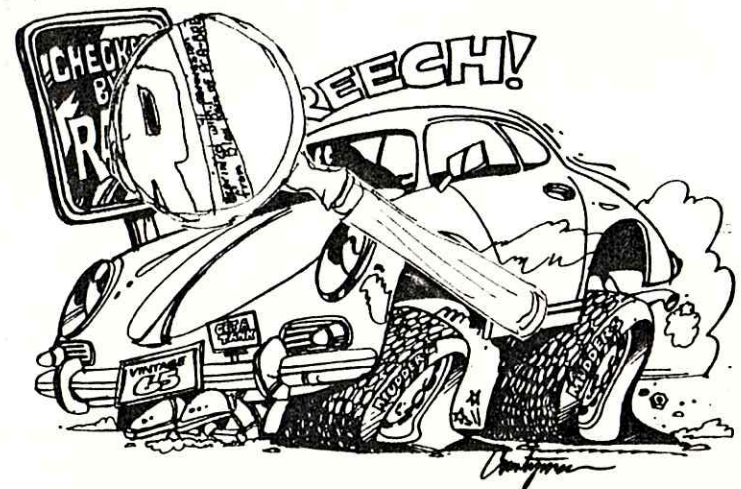

We're saving all kinds of junk in the house now in anticipation of the Scavenger Hunt.

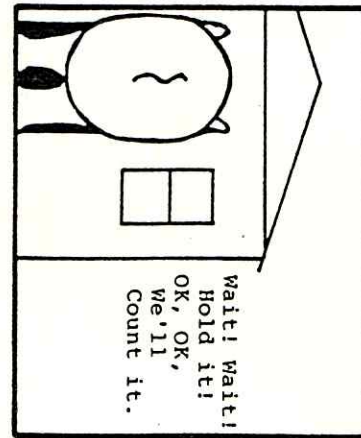
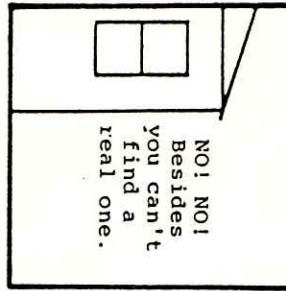
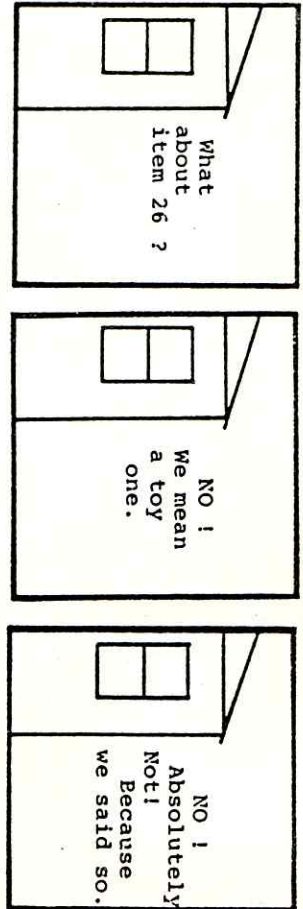
What's that analogy of pots and kettles? VMSC welcomes Chuck Madison to membership. Details to follow.

First: for each regular paid number you register, you are entitled to up to three fun runs at \$1 each, time permitting.

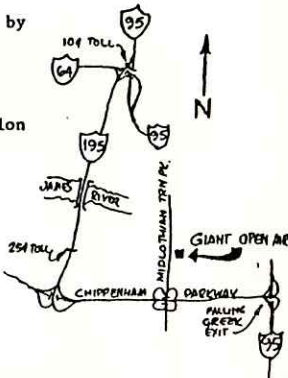

Problem of the Month Contest

This month's problems are a couple of old puzzles that I came across in some old puzzle books many years ago. Neither puzzle is very hard, and neither require any math above algebra. Each puzzle will be worth 10 points for a correct solution.

1) Two bicyclists are traveling toward each other on a straight road. One is traveling at 30 miles per hour and the other is traveling at 20 miles per hour. A fly is riding on the shoulder of the bicyclist traveling at 30 mph. When the two bicyclists are 2 miles apart the fly leaves the shoulder he has been riding on and flies to the shoulder of the other bicyclist. He then immediately turns around and flies back. He continues to go from shoulder to shoulder at a steady 60 miles per hour (with no time or speed loss in the turns) until the two bicyclists meet. How far does the fly fly?

2) The hands of a clock are all exactly together at 12 noon and 12 midnight. (Normal clock with Hour hand, Minute hand, and Second hand.) At what other times between noon and midnight are the Hour hand and Minute hand exactly together? Also, at what other times (if any) are the Hour, Minute, and Second hands together? Please give times to the nearest second.
