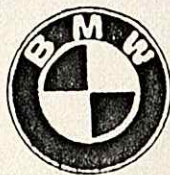

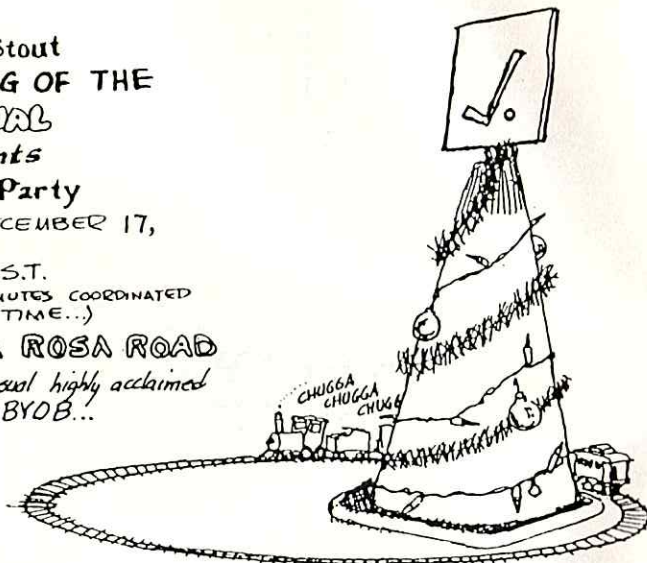

Official Results of the VMSC Competition Committee concerning; The Double  
Dastardly Digitg Rally of 10-23-83.

A protest was filed on leg 8 and was denied by the Committee.

The protest stated that a sign, placed along the rally course by the rally-  
masters, resembled an Emergency Sign to such an extent as to trick the contest-  
ants into turning onto an off-course loop. Since the Generals disallow the use  
of an Emergency Sign as the basis for a trap, it was felt that the sign in  
question was improper and therefore, the leg was wrong.

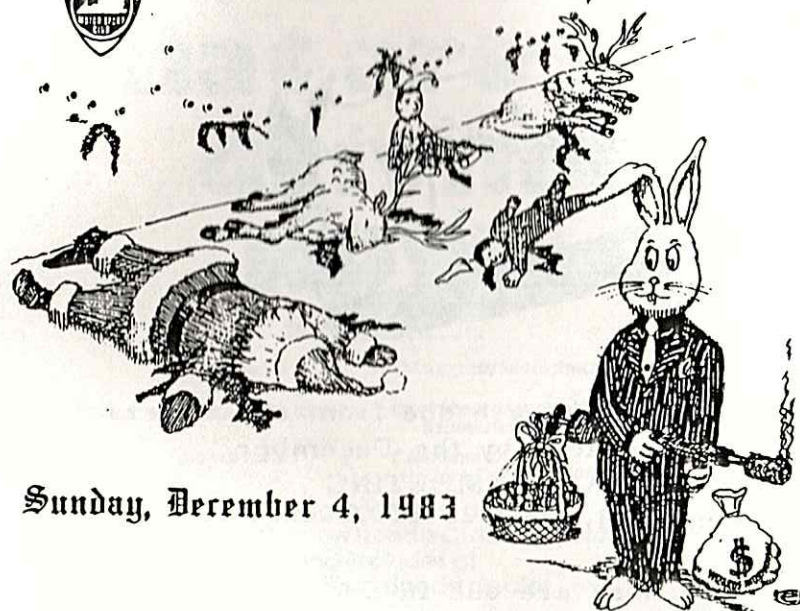
The Committee decided that the sign was not an Emergency Sign, since it did not  
contain the word "Emergency", as stated in the Generals. Also, the sign did not  
require the contestants to turn, since to do so meant that they had to assume  
they had missed another sign referenced in the previous N.I. The Committee  
felt that a sign or object that resembles another sign or object; and to trick a  
contestant, are both standard rally practices.

For the record:

- 1) The Committee felt that the sign in question was in poor taste, especially  
since any other type of sign would have created the same consternation on  
the part of the contestants.
- 2) The Committee strongly urges all future Rallymasters to refrain from using  
Emergency type signs and/or Emergency Signs, for any purpose other than their  
originally intended purpose (i.e. bona-fide Disasters).
- 3) Rallymasters and rallyists alike rely on Emergency Signs to circumvent major  
problems, and the Committee does not want to see VMSC reaching a point where  
contestants distrust our Emergency Signs.

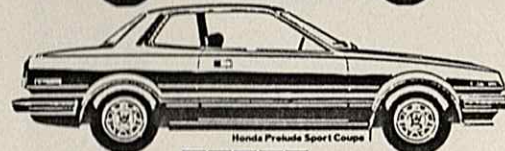
