4.1B/C/D THE NUMBER OF EQUIPPED/UNEQUIPPED/STOCK/STREET PREPARED/PREPARED AND MODIFIED CLASS YEAR-END AWARDS SHALL BE BASED ON ONE (1) AWARD FOR EACH SIX (6) VMSC MEMBERS OR FRACTION THEREOF WHO COMPETED IN THE EQUIPPED/UNEQUIPPED/STOCK/STREET PREPARED/PREPARED AND MODIFIED CLASS FOR THAT CALENDAR YEAR. A MAXIMUM OF THREE (3) POSITIONS (AND ANY TIES) CAN RECEIVE AWARDS.

CURRENT BYLAWS

PROPOSED BYLAWS

ARTICLE III
MEMBERSHIP

1. REGULAR MEMBERS

Membership in the Club shall be restricted to persons who are interested in the Club and its objectives. Applications for membership, accompanied by payment of the initiation fee and appropriate dues, must be signed by two members in good standing and approved by the Board of Directors. Effective January 1, 1980 new members must be at least 10 years old.

Membership in the Club shall be restricted to persons who are interested in the Club and its objectives. Applications for membership, accompanied by payment of the appropriate fees, as specified in the VMSC PRICE SCHEDULE, MUST be signed by two members in good standing and approved by the Board of Directors. Effective January 1, 1980, any new member must be at least 10 years old.

ARTICLE IV
DUES

- I. Annual dues shall be \$15.00 for a single membership. Annual dues for multiple memberships at a single address shall be \$15.00 for the first dues paying member, and \$7.50 for each additional dues paying member, and shall be payable on or before January 1.
- II. Applications received from new applicants after June 30 will be charged one-half (1/2) of annual dues.

DUTIES OF OFFICERS

VI TREASURER.

The Treasurer shall collect all dues and fees, maintain a complete and accurate voucher register, be responsible for all receipts and disbursements, present a monthly financial statement to the President, and present his records for annual audit. A CPA or at least three past Treasurers of the Club will serve on the Audit Committee. However, the immediate past Treasurer shall not be a member of this committee. The most recently elected Treasurer shall be a non-voting member of the Audit Committee.

The Treasurer shall collect all dues and fees, as specified in the VMSC PRICE SCHEDULE, maintain a complete and accurate voucher register, be responsible for all receipts and disbursements, present a monthly financial statement to the President, and present his records for annual audit.
