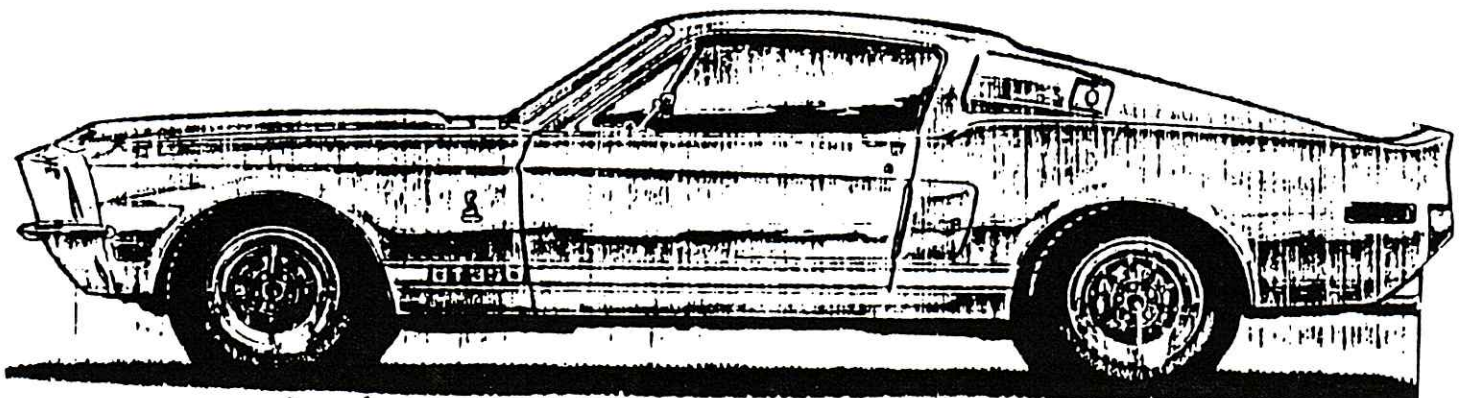
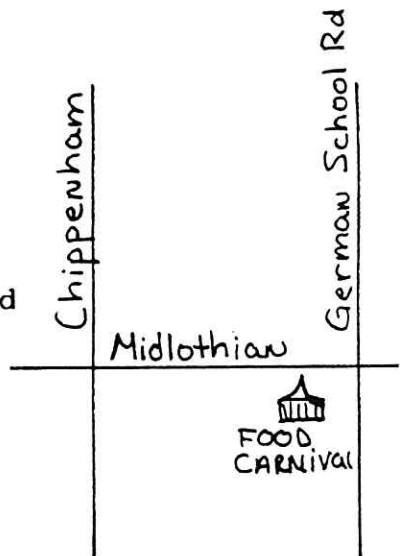

The OD's would like to thank all the people who came out and participated in the event and we especially want to thank all the workers even though there are to many to list. Maybe next year the weather will be a little better.

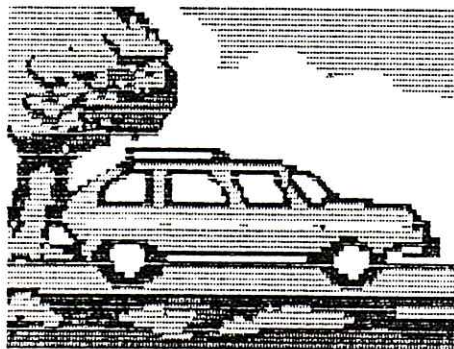
THE PARENT TRAP RALLY
